ORDER: -

As per the orders issued vide reference 1st, 2nd and 3rd cited, the implementation of pre-primary education under Samagra Shiksha for the academic year 2026-2027 has been initiated and applications invited to engage (Honorarium based) Instructors and Aayas to work temporarily (10 months only) in 39 identified Government, Local Body Pre-Primary sections in Primary Schools in Hanumakonda District.

As per the powers exercised by the District Collector and Chairperson Samagra Shiksha, Hanumakonda based on the report of the District Selection Committee the following candidates as per annexure enclosed are hereby engaged (Honorarium based) as Instructors and Aayas to work temporarily (10 months only) in 39 identified Government, Local Body Pre-Primary sections in Primary Schools in Hanumakonda District against their names.

Terms and Conditions of Engagement:

1. Engagement is purely temporary and on an honorarium basis, subject to the continuation with the academic requirement of Pre-Primary Sections. No claim for regularization will be entertained.
2. The selected candidates shall work under the supervision of the Headmaster and the control of the Mandal Educational Officer concerned.
3. They shall maintain punctuality, discipline, and good conduct in Discharging their duties.
4. This engagement does not confer any right for regular appointment or future absorption into Government service.
5. The services are liable to be terminated at any time without prior notice if their performance is found unsatisfactory, in case of negligence, irregularity, or violation of norm or on administrative grounds.
6. They shall abide by all instructions and guidelines issued by the school Education Department and this office from time to time.
7. They shall report to duty to the concerned MEO office, failing which their engagement shall stand cancelled /Selected candidates shall join duty within 3 days of receipt of orders, failing which the next eligible candidate from the approved panel shall be considered.
8. The services of Instructors and Aayas shall be periodically reviewed by the MEO and Headmaster concerned.

9. A declaration accepting all terms and conditions must be signed before assumption of duties
 10. Each Pre-Primary Instructor shall be paid a monthly honorarium of ₹8,000/- (Rupees Eight Thousand only) per month as per availability of budget.
 11. Each Aaya shall be paid a consolidated honorarium of ₹6,000/- (Rupees Six Thousand only) per month as per availability of budget.
 12. There are no eligible leaves available to Instructors and Aayas. In case any leave availed the monthly honorarium may be deducted as per number of days leave availed.
 13. At any stage and without any notice, the authority may revoke this order without any notice based on the circumstances.
 14. The Instructors and Aayas have no right to claim any privileges, benefits and allowances from the government.
 15. If they are in continuous absence of more than 10 days without prior permission from the higher authorities is deemed to terminate from the engage of services.
 16. The Instructors and Aayas should obtain the monthly work done certificate signed by the concerned Headmaster and submit the same to the respective MEO's.
 17. They are intimated to available at any time and any day (irrespective of holidays) as per the requirement of the School without fail.
 18. All Instructors and Aayas shall produce their original educational qualification certificates/documents for verification at the time of joining duty. Failure to produce the original certificates shall result in cancellation of the engagement and next merit candidate will be selected.
 19. If the enrolment strength of any Pre-Primary Section falls below 20 students, such school/Pre-Primary Section shall be treated as defunct. The services of the Instructors and Aayas working in such schools shall be adjusted against the vacancies available in Pre-Primary Sections having 20 or more students, based on administrative requirement, under the orders of the concerned Mandal Educational Officer (MEO) and Headmaster (HM).

Key roles (Duties) and responsibilities of Instructor:

Curriculum: Instructors are required to follow the curriculum prescribed by the State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT), which is aligned with the National Curriculum Framework for the Foundational Stage.

Instructors shall conduct teaching and learning activities, prepare academic material, and ensure holistic development of Pre-Primary children. Conduct classes as per the ECCE curriculum and implement play-based, activity-oriented learning. Maintain lesson plans, daily records, attendance, and coordinate with school staff for smooth transition to primary classes.

Planning and curriculum implementation

1. Lesson plan development: Design and implement age-appropriate, creative, and engaging lesson plans that focus on foundational academic skills such as basic literacy, numeracy, shapes, and colors.
2. Play-based learning: Incorporate a variety of educational techniques like storytelling, singing, games, arts, and crafts to make learning fun and stimulate curiosity and imagination.
3. Motor skill activities: Integrate activities that develop both gross motor skills (running, jumping) and fine motor skills (coloring, threading beads).

Classroom management and environment

4. Safe and nurturing environment: Create a clean, organized, and welcoming classroom that encourages children to explore, create, and make decisions with confidence.
5. Classroom discipline: Establish and consistently enforce rules of behavior that are age-appropriate, using positive discipline tactics.
6. Supervision: Provide appropriate supervision for children at all times to ensure their safety during lessons, play, meal, and nap times.

Child development and assessment

7. Holistic development: Facilitate the all-round development of children, addressing their cognitive, emotional, social, and physical needs.
8. Assessment: Observe and assess each child's developmental needs and progress on an ongoing basis. Adapt teaching methods and materials to meet their individual interests and learning styles.
9. Emotional support: Help children understand and manage their emotions, offering comfort and reassurance as they transition from home to a structured school environment.
10. Social skills: Encourage children to interact respectfully with peers, share, and participate in group activities to build their confidence and social competencies.

Communication and collaboration:

11. Parent-teacher communication: Maintain open and regular communication with parents regarding their child's progress, developmental milestones, and any concerns. This builds trust and ensures continuity between school and home.
12. Staff collaboration: Work with other teachers and staff to create and evaluate programs, implement lesson plans, and enhance the overall educational experience.

Administrative and miscellaneous duties

13. Resource management: Maintain a functional and tidy classroom and manage the inventory of classroom materials and supplies.
14. Emergency handling: Be prepared to handle emergencies and administer basic first aid if necessary.

Key roles (Duties) and responsibilities of Aayas:

1. Aayas shall support child care, cleanliness, serving of meals, and ensure safety and Well being of children and also assist teachers in maintaining hygiene, classroom safety, and child care & Support teaching-learning activities and ensure a child-friendly environment.
2. Aayas (also called school aides or helpers) in pre-primary schools are support staff responsible for a wide range of duties that ensure a safe, clean, and nurturing environment for young children. They work closely with teachers to support classroom activities and attend to the children's daily needs.

Child care and supervision

3. Assist with children's hygiene: Help children with personal needs, including using the toilet, washing hands, and maintaining overall cleanliness.
4. Supervise play and activities: Monitor children during play, both indoors and outdoors, and during meals to ensure their safety and well-being.
5. Assist with meals: Help with the distribution and serving of food and snacks. They also assist younger children who may need help with eating.
6. Manage rest time: Help to prepare children for nap or rest time and supervise them during this period.
7. Provide comfort and first aid: Comfort children when they are upset, and assist with minor injuries, providing basic first aid and reporting incidents to the teacher.

Classroom assistance

8. Prepare and organize materials: Help teachers set up the classroom for daily activities, arrange and organize learning materials, and clean up after lessons.
9. Assist with lessons: Support the teacher during lessons by reinforcing concepts with students individually or in small groups.
10. Manage behavior: Assist the teacher with classroom management by encouraging proper behavior and helping to resolve minor conflicts among children.
11. Decorate the classroom: Help create a stimulating and attractive learning space by assisting with displays and decorating bulletin boards. Health, safety, and cleanliness
12. Maintain premises: Keep the classroom, washrooms, and other pre-primary areas clean and hygienic throughout the day. This may include sweeping, wiping surfaces, and ensuring all areas are free of hazards.
13. Follow safety protocols: Ensure that all play equipment and classroom materials are safe and used correctly. They must also be aware of and follow emergency procedures.
14. Monitor health: Observe children for any signs of illness and report concerns to the teacher or a higher authority.

Administrative and parent communication

15. Maintain records: Assist with basic record-keeping, such as tracking student attendance.
16. Communicate with parents: Greet parents and help with pickup and drop-off procedures, ensuring children are released to the correct person.
17. Other duties: Perform other tasks as directed by the teacher or school administration to ensure the smooth operation of the classroom.
18. Timetable: The standard timing for activities in the centers runs from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 P.M.
19. Parental involvement: Instructors are expected to enlighten parents and the Community about the importance of early childhood care and education. They should also facilitate parent participation and inform them of their child's progress.
20. Reporting: Instructors must assist with the proper recording of student admissions in the School Admission Register and the UDISE+ portal. Health and safety: They are

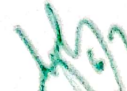
responsible for implementing child protection measures, ensuring physical and emotional safety, and adhering to emergency protocols.

Monitoring and supervision

21. Oversight: The performance of pre-primary instructors will be monitored at the Cluster, mandal, and district levels by respective educational officers.
22. Joint inspection: Coordinated monitoring visits by teams from the School Education, Women Development and Child Welfare (WDCW), and Health Departments will take place at least twice a year.
23. District committee: A District Convergence Committee, chaired by the District Collector will oversee implementation and address any issues.

In view of the above, the Mandal Educational Officers concerned are instructed to ensure that the engaged candidates listed in the Annexure shall join duty in the schools allotted to them, duly obtaining their joining reports and maintaining proper records and report compliance to this office without fail.
